Weather and Delay Procedure

The transportation department operations are impacted by many variables. The main one is weather, but others weigh in for a final recommendation. Here are the steps the department uses to help decide if operations need to be delayed or cancelled.

Step one: Weather (snow, ice, temperature, etc..) and well as other conditions that might affect our operations will be monitored.

Step two: Early morning checks of adverse conditions are monitored.

Step three: The process is repeated and may require the Transportation Director to drive on our roads to further investigate conditions.

Step four: Townships, boroughs, and state road, departments are contacted to acquire additional information on the conditions. The Director of Transportation needs information to determine if road maintenance crews are able to maintain and improve road conditions before district buses are scheduled to run.

Step five: A decision based on the preceding steps is made and students and staff are contacted by the ALERT NOW phone system of the decision. The delay or cancellation notice is also announced on these radio and television stations.
